

# Scenes & Musical Synopsis

The play takes place, in its entirety, in a French Court of Inquiry, late 1882. As the Court takes depositions from the various witnesses to the tragedy at their Opera House, their remembrances unfold on-stage. Each time we are led back into the Courtroom where yet another witness's recollections introduce us to a moment in time that provides a building block to understanding the mystery of the *Phantom of the Opera*.
